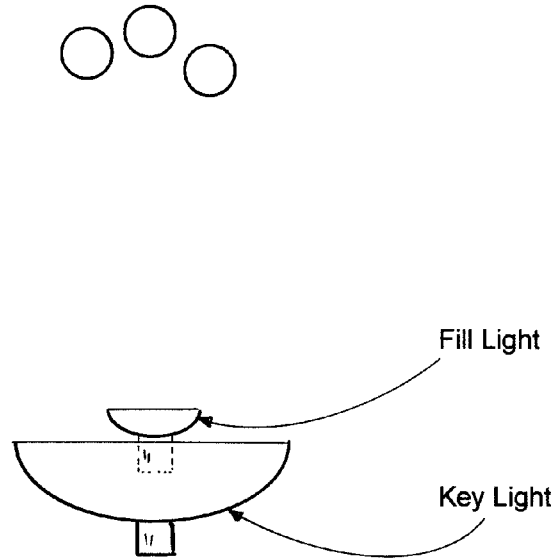

If the group is to be photographed outside, the lighting is best on a cloudy-bright day as the light is softer.

If it is sunny, pose the group either so that they are in the shade or with their backs to the sun. In the latter case, use reflectors or fill-flash to light the shadows.

If people face bright sunlight they tend to “squint”!
