

About us

Hemel Hempstead Photographic Society (HHPS) has been going for 83 years. We are a friendly club with a passion for having fun whilst learning how to improve our photography.

Our members vary from beginners to experienced photographers. Members use a mixture of cameras including phone cameras, compact cameras, advanced digital SLR and film cameras.

The society meets every Monday evening (except Bank Holidays) from September to June. Face-to-face meetings are held in the Salvation Army Hall in the middle of Hemel Hempstead. Other meetings are held on-line using Zoom. Meetings last from 19:45 until 22:00, and include a 10 minute break for tea/coffee and a chance to chat.

Our programme of events is varied. We have visiting speakers (e.g. a photographer presenting his/her genre of photography such as landscapes, portraits or street photography); practical photography workshops (e.g. to learn and practise particular photography skills or post-processing techniques); club competition evenings; and social events.

Why should I join?

HHPS provides some important benefits to its members. You can:

- Have a lot of fun with your photography and meet new people with similar interests, share your work, and get motivated and inspired by other photographers.
- Share ideas, ask questions, practise new techniques and significantly improve your photography.
- Learn from guest presentations on different genres of photography, composition and specific techniques such as lighting and posing a model (at our Studio Group).
- Enter your images in fun and league competitions. This means you get feedback from club members and experienced judges on both the technical and artistic aspects of your images. This is a very effective way to improve your photography.

Viewfinder

Members receive Viewfinder, which is our monthly journal produced for and by members of HHPS. Members also have access to the valuable back-catalogue of Viewfinder editions; these contain a wealth of highly informative articles plus examples of successful images by members with a description about how they were produced.
