About us

Hemel Hempstead Photographic Society (HHPS) has been going for 85 years. We are a friendly club with a passion for having fun whilst learning how to improve our photography.

Our members vary from beginners to experienced photographers. Members use a mixture of cameras including phone cameras, compact cameras, advanced digital SLR and film cameras.

The society meets every Monday evening (except Bank Holidays) from September to June. Face-to-face meetings are held in the Salvation Army Hall, 1 Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead, HP1 1ES. A few meetings are held on-line using Zoom. Meetings last from 19:45 until 22:00, and include a 10 minute break for tea/coffee and a chance to chat.

Our programme of events is varied. We have visiting speakers (e.g. a photographer presenting his/her genre of photography such as landscapes, portraits or street photography); practical photography workshops (e.g. to learn and practise particular photography skills or post-processing techniques); club competition evenings; and social events.

- Share ideas, ask questions, practise new techniques and significantly improve your photography.
